Experienced Education Expert Dr. Waqar's Training Session with Teachers at The AIMS

Enhanced Library Signage for Better Navigation





AIMS College conducted a session on Careers in Medical Field and Higher Education Opportunities

A Professional Development Center (PDC) session was held at The AIMS School and College, as part of the weekly guest lecturing series organized in collaboration with The AIMS Alumni Association. Mr. Muhammad Ikram, a consultant with the Ministry of Health and World Health Organization (WHO), delivered an informative session on "Careers in Medical Field: Convergence of Medical Disciplines with Others" to students from Grade 11 and 12. Mr. Ikram was warmly welcomed by CEO The AIMS Prof. Syed Imtiaz Ali Rizvi on his arrival. AIMS Alumni Association Completes Phase III of Relief Campaign: Aid Reaches 390 Families

The AIMS Alumni Association has successfully completed the third phase of its Relief Campaign, during which relief supplies were provided to 390 deserving families in Ali Pur, Punjab and Gilgit-Baltistan. This success marks a significant milestone in the continuous efforts driven by the spirit of human service and welfare. At the end of November, 80 packages containing warm bedding were dispatched to Skardu to help poor and deserving families in the cold, mountainous regions of flood-affected Gilgit-Baltistan cope with the severe weather. The Alumni Team ensured the proper distribution of packages,

guaranteeing that aid was delivered in an organized and accountable manner. Phase III of the Relief Campaign proved to be the largest and most effective phase so far, providing direct assistance to families in two regions. 310 families in Ali Pur Tehsil, Muzaffargarh District, Punjab and 80 families in GB received relief packages, thus reaching a total of 390 families. The success of this phase is the result of the team's effective planning, continuous hard work, and practical execution. The team conducted a pre-distribution survey of the area and identified needy families greatly affected by these floods.



PDC Session on Physical Literacy Emphasizes Importance of Active Lifestyle

A Professional Development Center (PDC) session was held at The AIMS School and College on November 8, 2025, as part of the weekly guest lecturing series organized in collaboration with The AIMS Alumni. Mr. Abu Zafar Sadiq, President of Adventure Society of Pakistan and Secretary in Islamabad Council for Traditional Sports and Games, delivered an informative session on "Physical Literacy" to students. Mr. Sadiq introduced the concept of physical literacy, explaining it as the motivation, confidence, physical competence, knowledge, and understanding to value and take responsibility for maintaining purposeful physical activity throughout life. He emphasized that true literacy encompasses not just academic knowledge but also physical wellness and active participation in sports and physical activities.



The speaker discussed the essential components of physical literacy including confidence, motivation, willingness, and enjoyment in participating in physical activities. He stressed that developing these attributes from a young age is crucial for lifelong health and well-being. Mr. Sadiq highlighted how physical literacy benefits students academically, socially, and emotionally, contributing to overall personal development. Addressing contemporary challenges, Mr. Sadiq expressed concern that today's children have become victims of the digital world, increasingly disconnected from health and physical activity.
