

Renowned Intellectual and Science Populariser Mr. Muhammad Ali Syed Visits The AIMS

Renowned intellectual and Science Populariser Mr. Muhammad Ali Syed visited The AIMS School and College, where he was warmly welcomed by Principal Mr. Roozi Ali and faculty members. The esteemed guest delivered an impactful talk to the teaching staff, emphasizing the intersection of faith, science, and education. In his address, Mr. Syed emphasized rationality and critical thinking, encouraging reflection on the wonders of Allah's creation manifest in the universe, animals, plants, and most significantly, the human being. He spoke about various scientific truths that align with the Qur'an, Hadith of the Prophet (PBUH), and sayings of the The Holy Prophet's Household, Ahlulbait (Peace be upon Them), many of which were revealed centuries ago but have only recently been confirmed through scientific advancement.

He noted that this is clear evidence that everything in the universe is a sign of Allah's presence, and that scientific discoveries reinforce Islamic knowledge rather than contradicting it. Mr. Syed urged that reflecting on these truths and advancing through invention and discovery is the responsibility of the Muslim Ummah. He advised teachers to exhibit exemplary character and to instill critical thinking and reflection among youth. 




