


Innovations in Education


The AIMS Pre-School Launches Healthy School Lunch Program Following International Standards

Each day features a meal option served to all students during break time, ensuring consistency and quality.




The AIMS Library Activities

The AIMS Alumni Association Begins Second Phase of Relief Goods Distribution for Flood Victims

The **AIMS Alumni Association** has launched the **second phase of its flood victim relief program**. In this phase, **relief goods are now being distributed** in a regular and organized manner in the affected areas after the initial collection of aid. After completing a **comprehensive survey in the affected districts of Punjab**, the team has set clear distribution targets and is now ready to deliver aid to deserving families.

The survey team conducted a detailed review of the **affected areas in Muzaffargarh, Jhang, and Multan**, where the severity of the human crisis was documented, and families in need of immediate assistance were identified. Based on ground observations, the Alumni Association has made an accurate **assessment of the number of affected families and the essential food items required** for distribution in these areas.

The organized distribution of relief goods began with the departure of the central team from Islamabad, which will oversee and coordinate all operations. The initial **distribution process has started in Jhang**, where the team will work under the supervision of the center to **ensure transparent and fair distribution**. This organized strategy guarantees that aid reaches those who need it most and that all operations adhere to The AIMS Alumni Association's principles of transparency and accountability.

The affected families will be provided with **food aid packages** to meet their immediate nutritional needs. In just the past day, with the help of local coordinators, the **team has delivered food relief packages to 115 affected families**. Each package contains essential food items – flour, rice, lentils, soap, dates, sugar, tea, ghee, milk, etc. The planning and implementation of this phase reflect the Alumni Association's commitment to providing purposeful and coordinated aid.

This second phase is a testament to **The AIMS Alumni Association's continuous spirit of humanitarian service and its complete dedication to the flood-affected communities**.

CEO Prof. Syed Imtiaz Ali Rizvi Delivers Inspiring PDC Session on Self Development

A **Professional Development Center (PDC)** session was held at The AIMS School and College Islamabad as part of the weekly guest lecturing series organized in collaboration with **The AIMS Alumni. Prof. Syed Imtiaz Ali Rizvi, CEO of The AIMS School and College**, served as the speaker for this enlightening session on "**Key Element in Self Development**," delivering a powerful message that resonated deeply with students. Prof. Rizvi emphasized the **critical importance of self-development** in becoming educated and responsible individuals. He stressed that **self-learning is the fundamental key element of personal growth** and development. He encouraged students to pursue knowledge for its own sake rather than merely for obtaining marks or passing examinations, explaining that genuine self-learners advance far in life while those who remain passive are left behind. Addressing common misconceptions, Prof. Rizvi clarified that success is not primarily a matter of capability or talent, as everyone is endowed with equal portions of these qualities. The real difference lies in **how effectively one utilizes their time**. He distinguished between self-education and formal education, urging students to develop the habit of self-learning as an essential life skill. The CEO highlighted that the world is changing at an unprecedented pace, making continuous self-teaching necessary for anyone who wishes to remain relevant and up-to-date.

He emphasized that **self-learning offers far more comprehensive education than traditional methods** alone. Prof. Rizvi particularly stressed the **importance of cultivating a reading habit**, noting that reading significantly increases concentration levels and cognitive abilities. Prof. Rizvi also introduced students to **diverse avenues of self-learning** including **podcasts, audiobooks, and documentaries**, encouraging them to create a lifestyle centered around continuous learning. He emphasized that exercising the mind is paramount and **advised students to read books across all genres and subjects**. Most importantly, he instilled the mindset that one can learn from everyone and every experience, provided they maintain the right attitude and openness. The session concluded with an **interactive Q&A segment** where students actively engaged with Prof. Rizvi, asking thoughtful questions and seeking clarification on various aspects of self-development. The CEO's approachable demeanor and practical advice created an atmosphere of genuine dialogue and learning. Students left the session feeling highly motivated and inspired to embark on their self-learning journeys. The session proved to be exceptionally impactful, with participants expressing **renewed commitment to developing habits that would serve them throughout their lives**. Prof. Rizvi's message successfully instilled in students the understanding that true education extends far beyond classroom walls and examination halls.

PDC Session on Role of Mathematics in the Era of AI and Path to Academic Excellence

A **Professional Development Center (PDC)** session was held at The AIMS School and College in collaboration with **The AIMS Alumni** as part of the weekly guest lecturing series. **Dr. Muhammad Yameen, PhD in Mathematics** and Senior Lecturer of Mathematics at The AIMS School and College, served as the speaker for this enlightening session on "**Role of Maths in the Era of AI and How to Get High Scores in Maths.**"

Dr. Yameen began by sharing his **personal educational journey**, explaining his decision to pursue mathematics because it is based on concepts rather than memorization. He emphasized a crucial **distinction between studying and learning**, noting that true understanding comes from passion and genuine engagement with the subject rather than merely pursuing grades.

Addressing the current state of mathematics education in Pakistan, Dr. Yameen highlighted that mathematics has unfortunately become a "formality subject". He urged students to approach mathematics with passion and genuine interest.

He also stressed that the true criteria of progress for any nation is not impressive infrastructure but **leadership in education**. He explained how logic, a fundamental branch of mathematics, plays a crucial role in **developing critical thinking skills essential in the modern AI-driven world**. Dr. Yameen also guided students about **various competitive tests** and pathways that can lead them to **admission in top universities**.

This session proved to be highly valuable for students, providing them with both **motivation and practical guidance on excelling in mathematics** while understanding its vital importance in the contemporary technological landscape.

Similarly, if a student has an aptitude for software, they can excel in using software applications across any field or profession, opening diverse career pathways.



Dr. Shah's message encouraged students to **view setbacks not as failures but as opportunities** to discover alternative paths to success. His emphasis on adaptability, resilience, and recognizing transferable skills provided students with a fresh perspective on career planning and personal growth .

Following the session, **CEO Prof. Syed Imtiaz Ali Rizvi** accompanied **Dr. Farman Ali Shah** on a **comprehensive tour of the institution**. 


