## Inauguration of the Center of Information Technology at The AIMS

The AIMS School and College, Islamabad, inaugurated its **Center of Information Technology (CIT)** in a ceremony. The event was graced by **Mr. Ammar Jaffri, CEO Pakistan Digital Vision 2047 and SDG Academy**, and **Senator Mian Attique**, recognized as **the world's first Digital Senator**.

## The AIMS School & College Conducts third party Quality Assurance test for Nazar e Quran classes

A team from the **Character Education Foundation (CEF)** visited The AIMS School and College, Islamabad as part of their **Quality Assurance initiative**. This celebration reflects The AIMS School and College's commitment to **nurturing national pride, cultural values**, and a sense of belonging among its students from the very earliest years of learning.






