The Professional Development Centre (PDC) of The AIMS, in collaboration with the **AIMS Alumni Association**, organized an **Emergency Response Training Session at The AIMS Hostel**. This important initiative was undertaken by The AIMS School & College to **equip students with essential life-saving skills**.

Following four-member expert team from **Rescue 1122** conducted the session:

- **Mr. Zeeshan Alvi** - Station Coordinator
- **Ms. Nosheen** - Community Instructor
- **Mr. Abdul Qadoos** - Shift Incharge
- **Mr. Usman Haider** - Fire & Rescue Officer

The program began with the recitation of the Holy Quran and Naat-e-Rasool (SAWS), followed by an introduction to the **role of Rescue 1122 in emergency situations**. The team delivered two practical demonstrations:

1. **Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)** : assistance for unconscious patients.
2. **First Aid for Bleeding Wounds:** methods to control blood loss and save lives.

Around forty hostel students participated and practiced the procedures under the guidance of the Rescue 1122 team. **Hostel warden Mr. Qalab Abbas** expressed **sincere gratitude to the Rescue 1122 team on behalf of The AIMS Administration** for their valuable training. 



Exciting Upgrade: The AIMS Main Library Welcomes the New Kids Library Corner!





Launch of a Relief Program for Flood Victims by AIMS Alumni

The AIMS Alumni Association (AAA), the official body of graduates of The AIMS School and College Islamabad, has organized **a program to help the victims of the recent floods**. The details are presented below.

1. Introduction

The **AIMS Alumni Association, comprising 250 members across Pakistan**, is committed to social responsibility under its motto ("Live for Service"). In light of the **recent devastating floods in Pakistan**, which have severely affected areas of Azad Kashmir, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Punjab, Sindh, and Gilgit-Baltistan, we consider it our duty to participate in **relief efforts to aid the affected families**.

This initiative will not only provide immediate assistance to the flood victims but will also engage you and the AIMS Alumni members in **meaningful social service**.

2. Objectives

1. To provide **immediate relief to families** affected by the floods.
2. To engage AIMS Alumni members in **humanitarian services**.
3. To foster a spirit of **social responsibility** among members.

3. Proposed Plan of Action

(a) Types of Aid

Hygiene Kit (Cost: Approximately PKR 3,000)

- * Bath Soap – 4 units
- * Laundry Soap / Detergent – 1 kg
- * Toothbrush + Toothpaste (Family Pack)
- * Sanitizer – 1 bottle
- * Masks – 10 units
- * Sanitary Pads (for women) – 1 pack
- * Mosquito Repellent Spray / Coil – 1 pack

Other Essentials (Cost: Approximately PKR 3,500)

- * Candle + Matches
- * Towel / Handkerchief
- * Children's Diapers (As needed)
- * Blanket or Shawl
- * Plastic Sheets (Tarpaulin)

Food Package (Cost: Approximately PKR 8,500)

- * Flour – 10 kg
- * Rice – 5 kg
- * Lentils – 2 kg
- * Sugar – 5 kg
- * Cooking Oil – 2 Liters
- * Tea – 500 grams
- * Milk Powder / Creamer – 1 kg
- * Biscuits / Dry Ration – As needed
- * Drinking Water – 6 Liters

Estimated Total Cost per Complete Relief

Packet: PKR 15,000

(Each packet will weigh approximately 25-30 kg and will be sufficient for a family of 5-6 people for at least 10-12 days.)

(b) Distribution Mechanism

1. **Representatives will be appointed** from among **AIMS Alumni volunteers** for each affected district.
2. The purchase of all relief packets, their packing, and dispatch to designated locations will be managed from Islamabad under the supervision of the **President of the AIMS Alumni Association (AAA), Mr. Ali Dost**. However, this work can also be carried out in other areas as needed. All these tasks will be performed under the **patronage of the CEO of The AIMS School and College, Syed Imtiaz Ali Rizvi**.

3. Collaboration with local administration, mosques/places of worship, and NGOs will ensure fair and transparent distribution.
4. Each team will submit a brief report (with pictures) to the central administration.

(c) Role of AIMS Alumni Members

1. **Financial Contribution:** Each member will contribute according to their capacity (charity begins at home).
2. **Volunteer Services:** Assistance in packing, transportation, distribution, participation in relief activities, and preparation of documentation/reports.
3. **Local Representation:** Members residing in the affected districts will oversee the operations directly.

4. Target Areas (Most Affected)

- * Khyber Pakhtunkhwa: Buner, Swat, Dir, Bajaur
- * Gilgit-Baltistan: Ghizer, Astore, Gilgit

5. Transparency and Monitoring

- * A **complete record of funds** and relief goods will be maintained.


