جو ہر وقت میرے ساتھ رہتا ہے



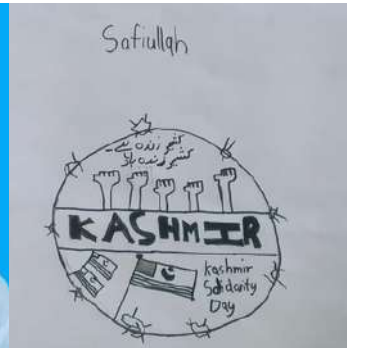

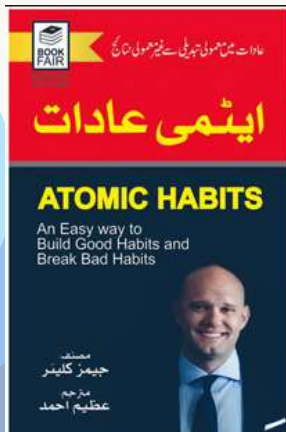

PDC SESSION ADDRESSES CRITICAL WATER CRISIS AND CONSERVATION

A Professional Development Center (PDC) session was held at The AIMS School and College on February 14, 2026, as part of the weekly guest lecturing series organized in collaboration with The AIMS Alumni Association. Ms. Asma Malik, Chairperson of Council for Water and Environment Preservation, delivered an urgent and thought-provoking session on Pakistan's water crisis and the critical need for water conservation.



Ms. Malik began by emphasizing a powerful truth: Water is life. She stressed that water has become a matter of national survival and national security for Pakistan. With alarming statistics, she revealed that Pakistan is among the top 5 countries that are water insecure, and the nation is rapidly moving toward absolute water scarcity. This is not a distant threat but an immediate crisis requiring urgent collective action. The speaker emphasized that we cannot keep our eyes closed to this issue. Water is a basic necessity, and its scarcity threatens every aspect of life. She stressed that we have to solve this issue together, making it

clear that water preservation is everyone's responsibility, not just the government's or environmentalists'. She discussed how human actions have exacerbated the water crisis. She explained that we did not leave green areas and made everything concrete, which has stopped water from being saved underground. The loss of green spaces and over-concretization have disrupted natural water absorption and groundwater recharge. The session featured lively discussion and active engagement from students, who participated in exploring potential solutions to the water crisis. Ms. Malik connected water conservation to

professional development, explaining that turning our dreams into reality requires responsible action, including environmental stewardship. She concluded with a powerful message: When we use water carefully, we fulfill our responsibility to current and future generations. This personal accountability framework helps students understand that their daily water-use choices have national significance. This impactful session raised awareness about Pakistan's critical water situation and empowered students to become advocates for water conservation in their communities.

PDC SESSION ON GLOBAL RESPONSIBILITIES OF YOUTH EXPLORES HUMAN POTENTIAL AND CHANGING WORLD ORDER

A Professional Development Center (PDC) session was held at The AIMS School and College, as part of the weekly guest lecturing series organized in collaboration with The AIMS Alumni Association. Dr. Nabi Raza Abidi, President WISE (World Islamic Summit on Education USA.) and Patron-in-Chief of Al-Kisa Foundation, USA, delivered a powerful and thought-provoking session on "Global Responsibilities of Youth". Dr. Abidi emphasized that Allah created humans with unlimited potential, yet sometimes we waste these God-given capabilities. He stressed that nothing is out of reach of anyone who commits to pursuing their goals with dedication and vision. He urged students to understand themselves in the context of the globe, recognizing their place in a rapidly changing world. The speaker advised students to

make a clear vision: what do you want to be. He recommended writing down goals in concrete terms and revisiting these annually to adjust pace and objectives as needed. This systematic approach to goal-setting helps students navigate their future with clarity and purpose. The speaker discussed the shifting global order, providing eye-opening statistics. He also taught students that Muslims once dominated the fields of science and encouraged them to reclaim this legacy of intellectual leadership. He emphasized that students' future in this changing world can be great if they position themselves strategically in the emerging global landscape. Addressing contemporary issues, Dr. Abidi stated that we face global challenges today that need comprehensive, holistic solutions. He emphasized that

your identity as a human comes first. He urged students to cultivate humanity and empathy, viewing all world affairs through an interconnected lens. This global perspective helps young people understand their responsibilities beyond national or religious boundaries. Dr. Abidi's message was ultimately one of hope: Don't wait for a miracle to happen. He reminded students that this is a world where anyone can rise from poverty to success regardless of background, citing numerous real-life examples of such transformations. Hard work, vision, and perseverance can overcome any obstacle. This inspiring session equipped students with a global perspective on their responsibilities and opportunities, encouraging them to think beyond limitations and embrace their potential to contribute to humanity's future.

PDC SESSION ON MESSAGE OF QURAN FOR HUMANITY AND GUIDANCE FOR LIFE

A Professional Development Center (PDC) session was held at The AIMS School & College as part of the weekly guest lecturing series organized in collaboration with The AIMS Alumni Association. Renowned Islamic Scholar and Educationist Hl Naeem ul Hasan Naqvi delivered a profound and spiritually enriching session on "Message of Quran for Humanity - Quran and Life". The speaker emphasized the fundamental importance of the Holy Quran in guiding humanity through all aspects of life. He explained that the Quran is like an instruction manual — follow its guidance and you will find redemption; ignore it and you risk self-destruction. The Quran provides comprehensive guidance for navigating social

issues, personal challenges, and spiritual growth. The scholar stressed that those who live according to Quran's teachings become a help to others, while those who ignore its wisdom may become harmful to society. He urged students to not just read the Quran but to think deeply about its meanings and reflect on its messages. Mr. Naqvi explained that the Quran refers to anger and negative emotions as fire — the fire of jealousy, envy, and greed. He warned that these destructive emotions become reasons for spiritual downfall. He quoted Quranic teachings about those who have eyes but do not see, ears but do not listen — referring to people who read the Quran without reflection. He emphasized that reading without

contemplation is meaningless. He stressed that righteous deeds must be founded on faith. The scholar beautifully explained that the Quran addresses the issues of every day, every home, and every situation. He encouraged students to turn to the Quran when facing problems, as its wisdom provides solutions to all challenges. Whoever comes under the shade of Quran becomes capable of all capabilities, he stated, highlighting the transformative power of divine guidance. This spiritually uplifting session inspired students to develop a deeper relationship with the Holy Quran, approaching it not as a ritual but as a living guide for navigating life's complexities with faith, and moral integrity.
