# This Month At AIMS

## THE AIMS HOLDS PRAYERS FOR MARTYR AYATOLLAH KHAMENEI AND SCHOOL CHILDREN

The AIMS School & College held a special gathering to condemn the brutal attacks on Iran resulting from Israeli and American aggression. It commemorated the martyrdom of Ayatollah Syed Ali Khamenei' along with his family members and the tragic killing of 148 innocent schoolgirls in an USA- Israeli bombing of a girls' school in Iran. The teachers and students were present on this occasion. The students were informed about the devastating attacks in Iran against international law and human norms and values. Fateha (prayers for the departed souls) was offered by the entire school community. The cruel and cowardly attacks on innocent

children, civilians and revered spiritual and intellectual figures of global respect were strongly condemned. The assembly paid tribute to Ayatollah Syed Ali Khamenei's services to Islam, the Muslim Ummah, Palestine and humanity. The attendees strongly condemned the inhuman attack and assassination of Ayatullah Syed Ali Khamenei' who was a globally revered religious personality, great scholar and leader, against all norms, human values, morality and international law. They also condemned the massacre of innocent schoolgirls, emphasizing the brutality of targeting educational institutions and children. The faculty and administration urged the world's

nations and organizations to fulfill their responsibilities by putting an end to the killing of children and spiritual leaders by foreign powers, and to play an effective role in establishing peace in the world. Additionally, senior students were shown a documentary video about the life and contributions of Ayatollah Syed Ali Khamenei, providing them with a deeper understanding of his leadership and dedication to the Muslim world and global peace. The AIMS School & College stands in solidarity with the people of Iran during this tragic time and condemns all acts of aggression against innocent civilians and educational institutions.

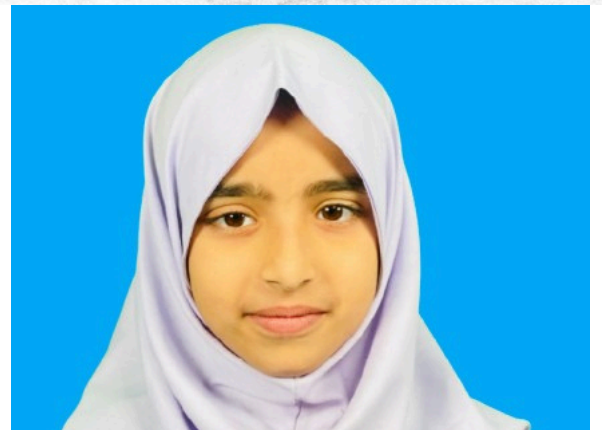
### Celebrating the Spirit of Ramadan Through Creativity

# THE AIMS SCHOOL & COLLEGE ACHIEVES 97% PASS RATE IN ANNUAL EXAMS 2025–26

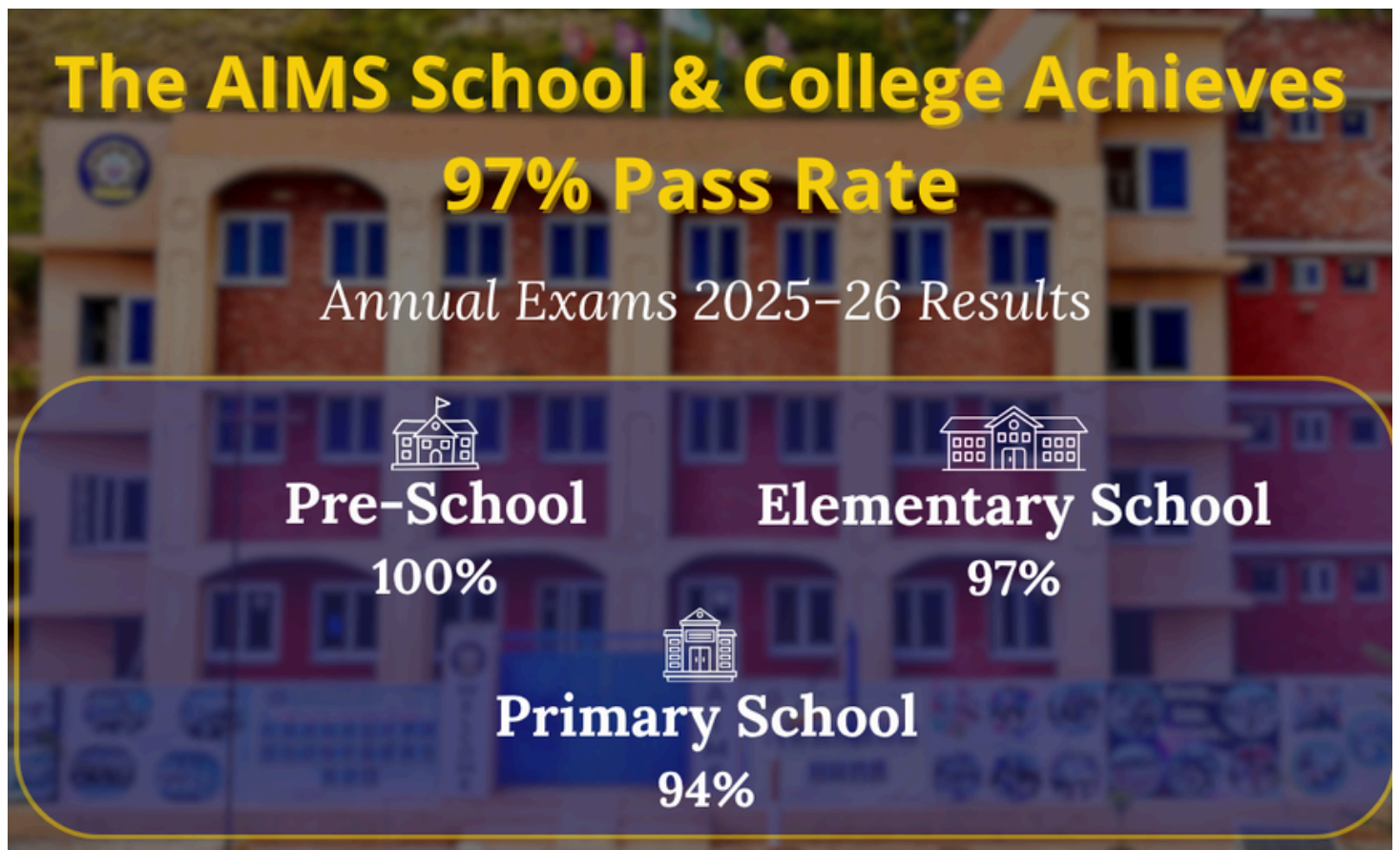
The AIMS School & College is proud to share the results of the Annual Examinations for Session 2025–26, covering Pre-School to Grade 8. This year, 97% of students have successfully passed their exams — a wonderful achievement that reflects the hard work of everyone in our school community.

Pre-School students gave an outstanding performance with a 100% pass rate. Elementary School followed with 97%, and Primary School achieved 94%. These numbers show that our students across all levels are learning, growing, and doing well.

What makes this result even more special is the progress compared to last year. In Session 2024–25, the overall pass rate was 93%. This year, it has risen to 97%. The number of students scoring A+, A, and B grades has also increased, while the failure rate has dropped from 7% to just 3%.

The management would like to sincerely thank our teachers, academic coordinators, and administration staff for their dedication and tireless support throughout the year. Their efforts inside and outside the classroom made this success possible. A heartfelt thank you also goes to our parents, whose trust, encouragement, and involvement continue to make a big difference in their children's learning journey. 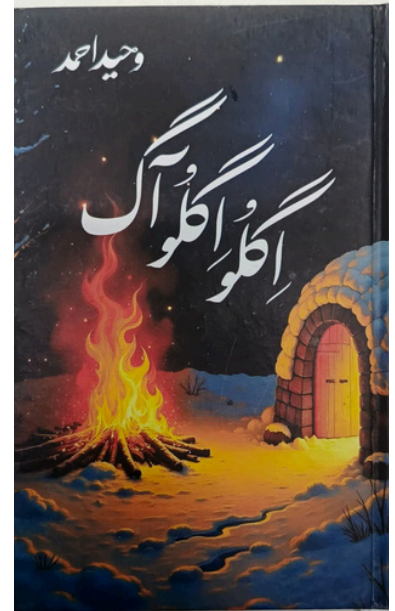
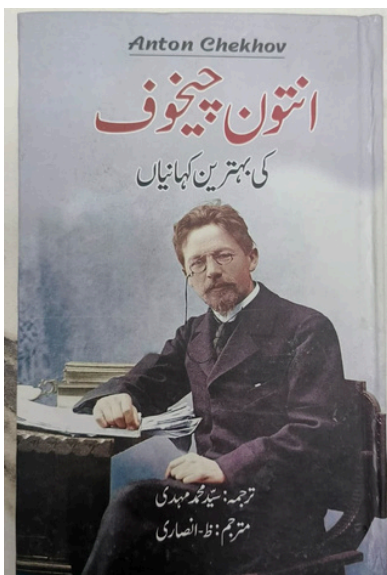
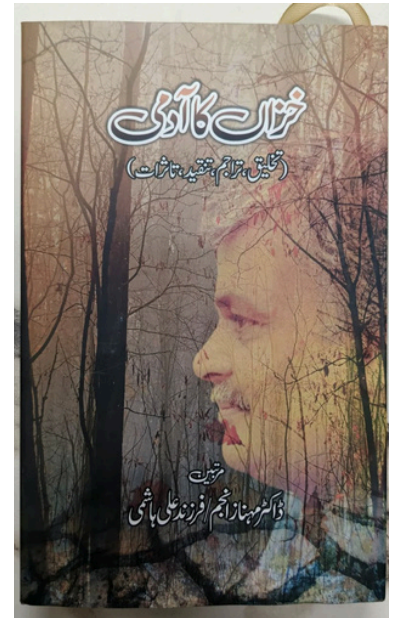
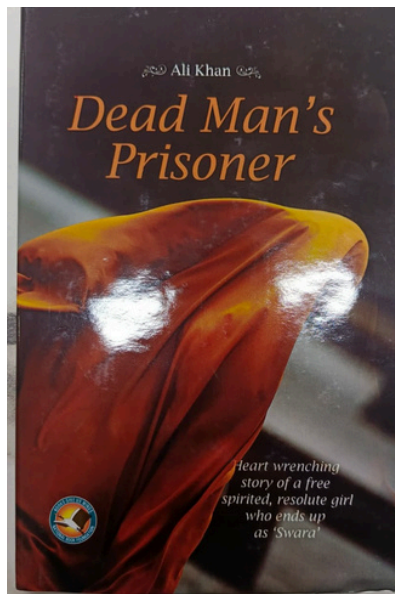
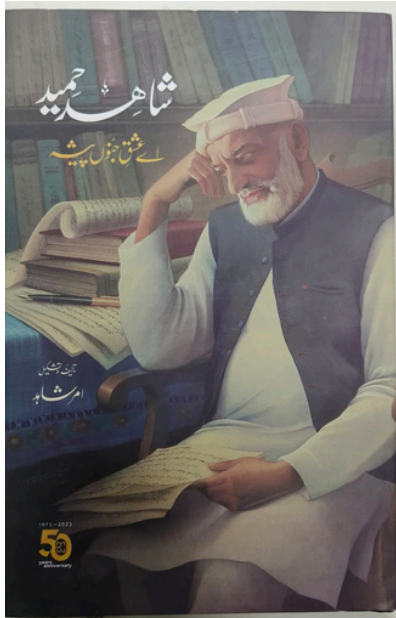
# The AIMS Library Activities

# NEW ISLAMIC LITERATURE SECTION INTRODUCED AT THE AIMS LIBRARY

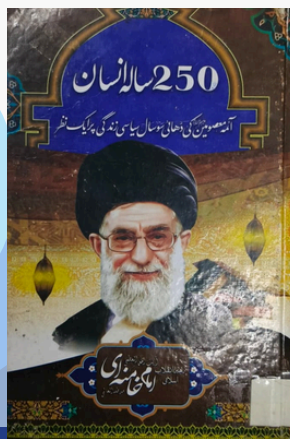

## RAMADAN PROGRAM SESSION ON QURAN AND QUALITIES OF ALLAH'S SERVANTS

A Professional Development Center (PDC) session was held at The AIMS School & College as part of the weekly guest lecturing series organized in collaboration with The AIMS Alumni Association. Renowned Islamic Scholar and Educationist Maulana Asghar Askari delivered an enlightening session on "Quran and Servants of Allah", exploring Quranic teachings about the characteristics of righteous believers. Maulana Asghar Askari described the significance of the Holy Quran and emphasized the importance of comprehending its meanings rather than merely reciting it. He discussed selected verses from Surah Furqan, focusing specifically on the signs of the people of Rahman (the servants of the Most Merciful) as described in the Quran. The scholar outlined key qualities that distinguish the true servants of Allah. The first quality is possessing humility and modesty in one's character, avoiding arrogance and selfishness. True servants of Allah walk with humility, treating others with respect and recognizing their own limitations before the Creator.

The second quality is the ability to forgive others and refrain from seeking revenge. Maulana Askari emphasized that Allah's servants overlook the faults of others and choose forgiveness over retaliation, embodying divine mercy in their interactions with fellow human beings. The third quality is that they spend their nights in worship and prayer, dedicating time to connect with Allah when others sleep. This commitment to late-night prayers and devotion demonstrates their prioritization of spiritual growth over worldly comforts. The session concluded with an interactive Q&A segment where Maulana Asghar Askari addressed students' questions and engaged in meaningful dialogue. This exchange allowed students to clarify their understanding and seek guidance on applying these Quranic teachings in their daily lives. Principal Mr. Roozi Ali expressed heartfelt gratitude to Maulana Asghar Askari for his enlightening session, thanking him for sharing profound Quranic wisdom that inspires students to embody the qualities of true servants of Allah.



## THE AIMS STUDENTS PARTICIPATE IN A NATIONAL COMPETITION OF QURAN
