Innovations in Education

THE AIMS SCHOOL & COLLEGE PREPARED 13 POINTS MEDIA EVALUATION FRAMEWORK FOR EDUCATION AND CHARACTER BUILDING AND LAUNCHED A PILOT PROJECT

An orientation session for teachers on the Media Evaluation Framework was conducted at The AIMS School & College as part of the institution's ongoing efforts to ensure that educational media content shown to students aligns with the school's values, vision, mission, and educational standards.

At the beginning of the session, Principal The AIMS, Mr. Roozi Ali, introduced the The AIMS Media Review Committee and explained the purpose behind the formation of the committee as well as the objectives of the orientation session. He emphasized the importance of carefully selecting educational media content that positively contributes to students' intellectual, moral, and character development while remaining aligned with the institution's educational philosophy and standards.

The session was conducted by Mr. Ibn e Hasan Bukhari, research scholar, digital creator, and member of the Media Review Committee of The AIMS. During the session, he introduced teachers to a detailed Media Evaluation Framework developed by the committee for assessing video content before it is shown to students.



The framework consists of 13 evaluation points along with a structured scoring system and approval criteria designed to help teachers systematically review educational videos. Each point of the framework was explained in detail through practical video examples and an interactive practice evaluation activity, enabling teachers to better understand the application of the criteria in real classroom situations.

With this orientation session, The AIMS School & College officially launched a one-month pilot project for media evaluation. During this period, teachers will evaluate video content shown to students according to the approved framework, while feedback and observations will be collected for further refinement and improvement of the system.

This initiative reflects the commitment of The AIMS School & College to ensuring that students are provided with educational media content that is not only academically beneficial but also aligned with the institution's values, vision, mission, and broader goals of character building and holistic development.

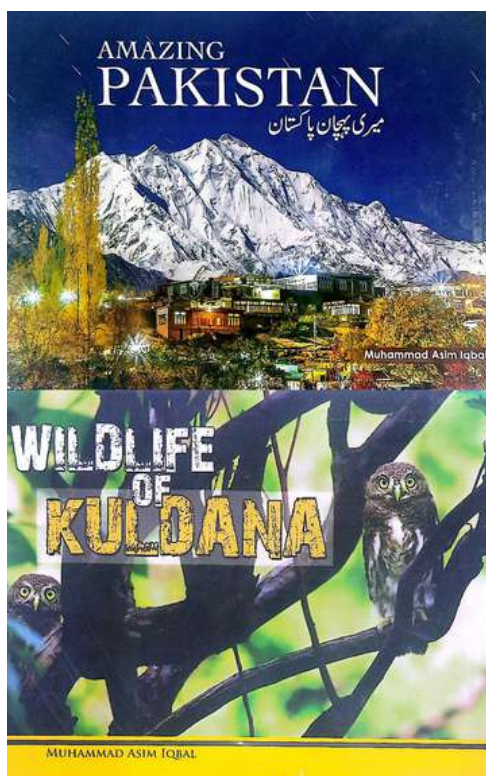
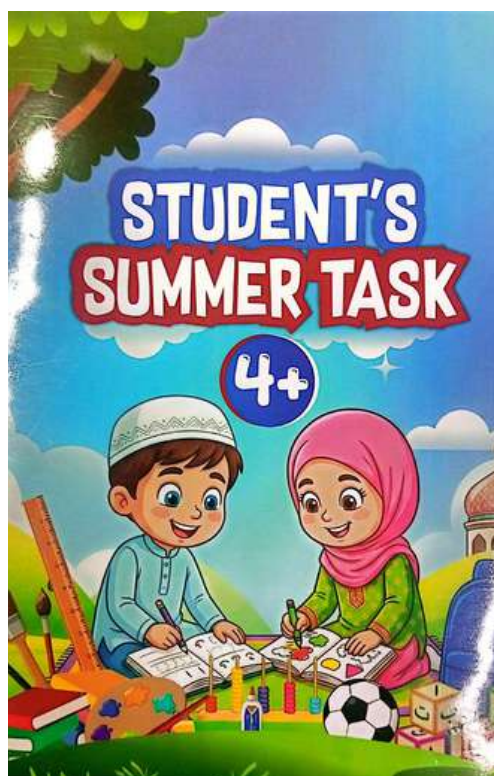

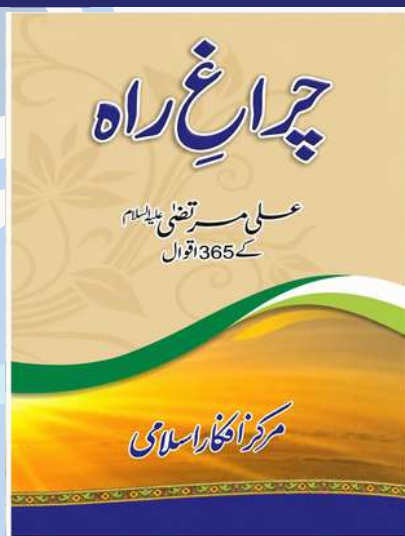

PDC SESSION HELD AT THE AIMS BOYS HOSTEL ON CHARACTERISTICS OF THE SERVANTS OF ALLAH

A weekly session of the Professional Development Center (PDC) was held at The AIMS Boys Hostel, where renowned scholar and Mission Director The AIMS Allama Asghar Askari delivered an insightful lecture on the Characteristics of the Servants of Allah in the light of the Holy Quran.
