STUDENTS ENGAGE IN BOOK REVIEW ACTIVITY ON THE THEME OF HARD WORK

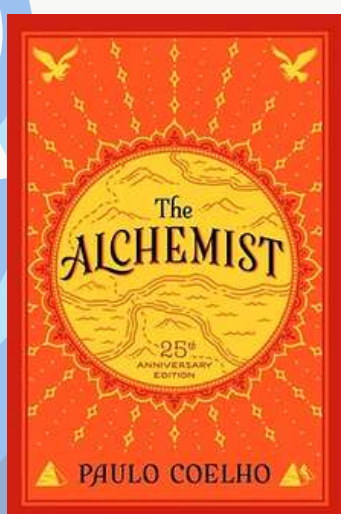
