Today, we pay homage to a great educationist, a visionary administrator, and a true architect of the beautiful synthesis of faith and worldly life, Syed Aleem Haider Zaidi. He was not only an exemplary teacher but also an intellectual leader who envisioned education as a pathway to spiritual and practical life, and brought that vision to reality.

His association with The AIMS School and College and its affiliated educational institutions began on March 22, 2013, and just days later, on April 1, 2013, at a historic meeting, he strengthened this foundation of knowledge and wisdom. In that meeting, it was resolved to design an educational system that integrates religious training with modern sciences, technology, and social sciences in such a manner that students could achieve both worldly success and moral excellence. It was from this vision that the motto "Education for Civilising" emerged.

To achieve the objectives set forth in this important meeting, an Educational Cell comprising several experts was formed, and as a co-worker, he not only provided intellectual guidance but later, as the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the expanded Central Management Committee, he gave this mission a structured and effective direction.

On July 3, 2013, this great project was named "Alam ul Huda Education System," and then on February 4, 2014, Syed Aleem Haider Zaidi presented a comprehensive document outlining the Vision, Mission, Rationale, objectives, and a complete strategy for their achievement. His comprehensive program was structured in two phases, centered on the idea that our students should play a full role in every field of practical life—whether economic, social, commercial, or research-oriented—and adopt the noble character of the Holy Prophet ﷺ and his Ahl al-Bayt as their role model in their professional conduct.

In his view, character building was fundamental to the personality development of students, so that every aspect of life could be shaped in the light of faith.

The AIMS School and College adopted the intellectual model of the Alam ul Huda Education System, which is now known as the AIMS Education System. It is noteworthy that the late Aleem Haider Zaidi's contribution to this educational system was not limited to intellectual guidance; he also provided financial support according to his capacity and always rendered selfless services for its advancement.

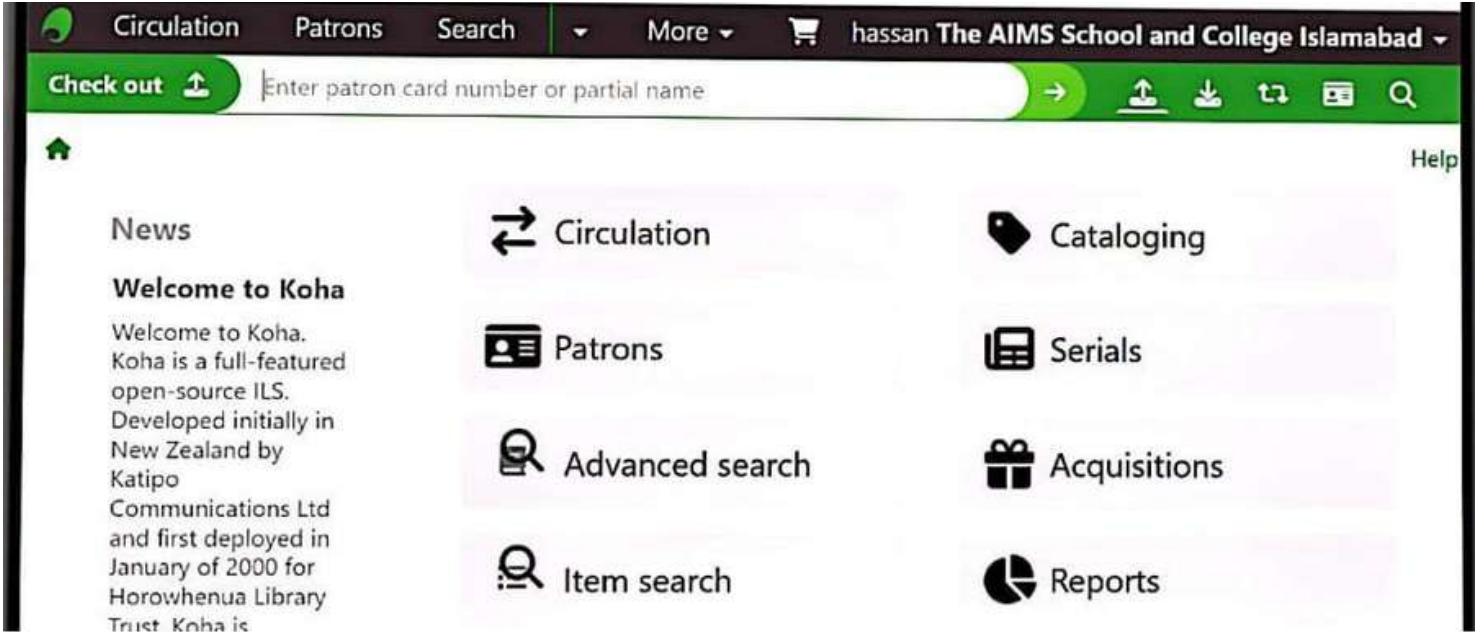
20 NEW BOOKS ADDED TO THE AIMS LIBRARY
